Ride on the only preserved section of the historic Kettle Valley Railway line built between 1910 & 1915.

Originally 325 miles long, the KVR is said to be one of the most difficult railways ever built. You'll enjoy a 90 minute nostalgic journey through the rural beauty of Summerland, & onto the Trout Creek trestle bridge with spectacular views of Okanagan Lake & the Trout Creek canyon below.

Our majestic 106 year old locomotive, "the 3716", thrills young & old alike as it steams along the track. Live music, historical commentary, & an observation game for the kids, completes your unique railway adventure.

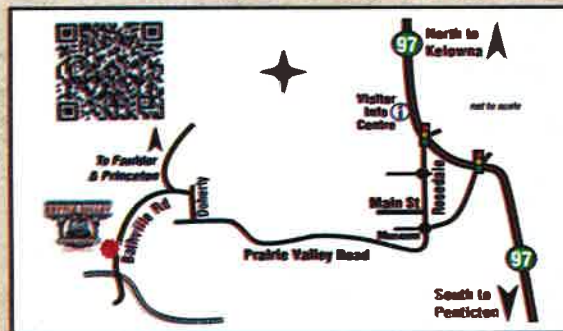

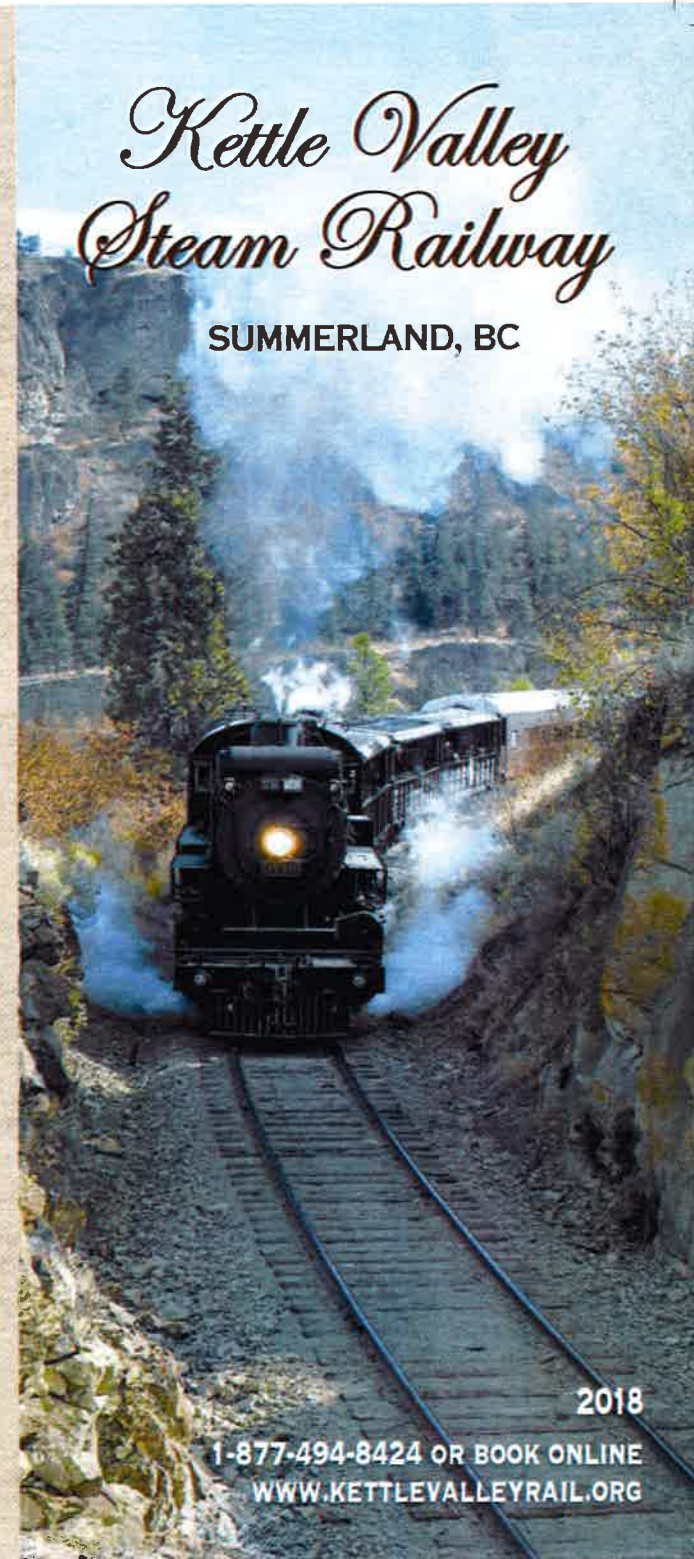
