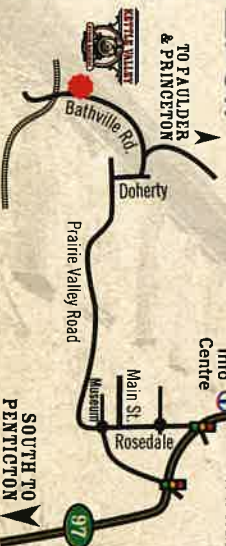

You'll enjoy a 90 minute nostalgic journey through the rural beauty of Summerland and onto the Trout Creek trestle bridge with spectacular views of Okanagan Lake and the Trout Creek canyon below.

Our majestic 108 year old locomotive "the 3716" thrills young and old alike as it steams along the track. Historical commentary and an observation game for the kids completes your unique railway adventure.
